

31st Edition of the SUNCINE International Environmental Film Festival** From November 1 to 23, 2024

The SUNCINE International Environmental Film Festival is proud to announce the selected films in competition for its sections: Official, Ñ Official, Miradas, and Monarca, which form the core of its 31st edition, to be held from November 1 to 23, 2024.

The festival, recognized as the oldest of its kind in the world, will take place in the cities of Calafell, Barcelona, and Viladecans with in-person screenings and a wide online offering to reach all audiences interested in environmental awareness through cinema.

In addition to screenings at the physical venues, the audience will be able to enjoy the selected films through digital platforms such as APP SUNCINE, Play RENFE, 3cat, and CaixaForum+, which will serve as the online venue for the Official Section. Moreover, public television channels Betevé and TV3 (Televisió de Catalunya) will broadcast a selection of exclusive festival content, further expanding the reach and visibility of environmental cinema.

Sections in Competition:

- Official Section: Showcases the most outstanding feature-length films from the international scene, addressing the climate crisis and environmental challenges through an artistic and committed perspective. These films will compete for the festival's top award, the Golden Sun.
- Ñ Official: This section highlights environmental audiovisual productions from Spain, featuring a selection of feature-length documentaries that reflect the diversity of environmental issues and solutions within the country.
- Views: Dedicated to new perspectives and narratives, this section presents innovative and fresh works up to one hour in length, exploring the relationship between humans and the environment through creative and disruptive approaches.
- Monarca: A section aimed at younger audiences, featuring short films and animations designed to inspire future generations in their commitment to the planet. This space also serves as a learning platform for students and educators.

Schedule and Access to Screenings:

- In-person screenings: From November 1 to 8 in the cities of Calafell, Barcelona, and Viladecans.
- Digital platforms: From November 1 to 23 via APP SUNCINE, Play RENFE, 3cat, and CaixaForum+.
- Television broadcasts: Betevé and TV3 (Televisió de Catalunya) will offer selected festival content.

With this extensive program, SUNCINE reaffirms its commitment to promoting education and environmental awareness through cinema, inviting all audiences to reflect on the state of our planet and the necessary actions for its preservation.
